



THEY RESISTED IN THE WARSAW GHETTO

In April 1943, the first ever armed revolt against the Nazi occupier breaks out in the Warsaw Ghetto. Born out of desperation and bound to fail, the uprising erupts with extraordinary ferocity, becoming one of World War II's central events. The identity of its key fighters, however, has mostly been forgotten, and few remember that many of those heroic Jewish fighters were women.

The film revisits the account of two of these women, Cywia Lubetkin and Rachel Auerbach, who survived their people's extermination and whose stories have never been told before. Through the interlinked stories of their fate, the film sheds light on neglected, unknown aspects of the Warsaw revolt. Using never-seen-before photographs and video archives, the film invites us to explore the connections between individual lives and the march of history.

Among the thousands of letters sent to the Vichy administration between 1941 and 1944, two almost identical letters addressed to Marshal Pétain were written one day apart in August 1942 by a young Polish man, Léon Kacenelenbogen.

Interned in the Vichy camps, what became of the author of these two moving pleas? After weeks of research, we managed to learn that this young man survived. He eventually died at the age of 98 in Belgium. He never really told anyone what had happened to him. What took place during the life of this man about whom we know almost nothing? What kind of life did he have in the years between 1939 and 1948, when the world was turned upside down? The film will lift the veil on Léon's extraordinary journey through Poland, Belgium, France, Spain, Palestine, and Israel.

THE RECLUSE AFTER 1944 PURGE

October 1983, Saint-Flour in France. It is 6 a.m. when a detonation shatters the door to a small house in the upper town. The GIGN's men rush inside and, in horror, among the piles of rubbish, discover Esther Albouy (age 60) and her brother Hubert (age 41). In the next room lies the body of their brother Rémi, who died two years earlier. The newspapers immediately pick up the story: Esther's head was publicly shaven in 1944, accused of "horizontal collaboration" when the town was liberated. Her parents were so ashamed that, from then on, they kept her permanently locked indoors without anyone around them so much as raising an eyebrow.

This is where our historical investigation starts.

LEBANON 1982RADIOGRAPHY OF A MASSACRE 52' | 2023

A deeply moving documentary that takes us to the heart of the horror experienced by Palestinian refugees during the Sabra and Chatila massacre in Lebanon in September 1982. Despite the historic impact of the event, there has been no conviction in forty years. The film gives a voice to witnesses, victims to the events, including the novelist Jean Genet, who was one of the first to enter the camps after the carnage. By exploring declassified archives in Israel and Lebanon, and gathering previously unseen testimonies, the documentary sheds light on both the motives and the circumstances that made the tragedy happen. Through the gripping accounts of the perpetrators and victims, the film also deciphers the historical and geopolitical issues behind this massacre, which irrevocably changed the face of the Middle East.

DIARY OF A MAID THE STORY OF FÉLICITÉ LAVERGNE


Félicité Lavergne leaves her farm in the mountains of central France at the age of fourteen to embark on a tragic, dramatic, and unexpected journey. A farm girl, a maid and then a chambermaid, she moves from the countryside to the city, across France, in the first part of the twentieth century, with both courage and innocence. In each new place, Félicité faces the unknown. She must adapt to a new way of life. She experiences loneliness and seclusion yet dreams of a better life.

Based on written testimonies of seven maids, the documentary draws up an intimate portrait of an 'invisible' woman in Europe amid major transformations of the Belle Époque era, while combining archives and evocative scenes. It tells the story of a hard, violent life, with joys achieved through great struggle. *Diary of a maid* is a film about the status of women, about social violence, about male and bourgeois domination.

After multiple attempts to reach the island of Lesbos, they finally arrived in the chaos of the Moria camp where 25,000 migrants struggle to survive. One day, an NGO lent her a small camera and she started filming her daily life. She never stopped. The camera became her way to survive the horror of war and the wounds of exile.

The film is constructed as an intimate diary of Elahe's long road towards freedom, narrated by her voice. She captures the emotional roller coaster of a child's life fleeing war, endlessly documenting survival from the hell of Moria and her narrow escape from the fire that devastated the camp, to being resettled in yet another undignified and unsafe camp, the tedious transfers to unknown locations and gloomy migrant hotels, asylum requests, and hopefully ultimately permanent residency somewhere in Europe.

Whether a colorful scale from 0 to 10 or 1 to 5 playful stars, it's quick, machine-like and painless for the person providing the rating. Behind it, however, lurks a biased labor monitoring system fueled directly by the customer, unbeknownst to him. Added to this are a multitude of invisible ratings which serve as raw material for algorithms used by secretive companies that claim to be able to predict the future.

The film takes a critical look at the "democratization" of rating systems and the consequences of this practice in our personal lives and for our collective freedoms.

Today, he ventures to reopen the pages of his family history by meeting the men and women who knew, loved and guided her, and who, each in their own way, possess a fragment of Didy. For the entire world, Christopher Reeve and Superman are one and the same. Over forty years after the release of Richard Donner's international blockbuster, Christopher Reeve remains the absolute reference as regards the role of the superhero from Krypton.

How did the American actor manage to merge so marvellously with his character? Why has no attempt, however praiseworthy, managed to make us forget Superman of 1978? 




